It gives me a great deal of happiness to reflect on the 2022/23 season that has been for Surf Coast Little Athletics in only its second season.

This second year of operation has seen our club strengthened and we can be confident that athletics is now firmly embedded within our community in a way which means we are here to stay.

At the start of our 2022/23 season, things were not all smooth sailing. We struggled to operate on our designated oval right from our first line marking day until about week four of our program. This was due to a combination of wet grounds, long grass and our stakeholders still developing an understanding of what is involved in operating a little athletics competition.

Behind the scenes however, with some new members of our committee on board, we were able to work through some improved

operating arrangements between our club and Torquay College, as well as with the council to ensure our facilities met our competition needs each week.

The club's inaugural Championship Day was a resounding success bringing smiles all around to both children and parents alike.

By the end of the season, I was overjoyed to see that little athletics had become a significant enough event for spectators to pull out their camping chairs and perch above the track to observe the activities of our Saturday morning competition.

A huge thanks must go out to our Gold Partner, McCartney Real Estate who has supported us from our first year. We are also delighted to have Torquay's Kip McGrath supporting us as a Silver Partner for both this season gone by and again for 23/24. We are also pleased to have had The Running Company Geelong support us as a Bronze partner and offer some bonus giveaways to our members. This support gives us the opportunity to dream big for the future of our club and we are thrilled to have businesses supporting us who are well aligned with the community of little athletes and their families, and we hope to continue these partnerships ongoing.

We are also exceptionally grateful to the wonderful grant funding which we received, \$2,000 from Torquay Community Enterprises, \$2,000 from Commonwealth Bank, \$3000 from the Surf Coast Shire & \$5,000 from Coles Supermarkets. Together these grants were able to pay for us to get the electronic timing equipment and has ultimately

elevated the way in which we accurately record athlete performances each week.

Looking on from the campaign started to establish a dedicated athletics facility for the Surf Coast region, our committee has continued to work with the Surf Coast Shire, and I am pleased to say that our club will make a move to operating from Polwarth Oval in our 2023/24 season.

Although this means a shift in the timing of our competition to Friday night's which may not be optimal to all members, it is wonderful to have the backing of our council to progress Little Athletics so that we can continue to grow and cater to the needs of our members.

SSurf Coast Little Athletics (SCLA) entered its second season of competition with great enthusiasm on the back of a successful FY22 launch season and wonderful community support and feedback.

Income

Total Income was \$39,064.27 for year ending 30 June 2023. Sponsorship and grants were the major contributors to total income, with \$25,600 received during the year.

Membership fees for the year were \$9,832.35, with 123 registered members (17% increase on the previous year).

And it was exciting to see continued growth in our club with a 17% increase in memberships, 11% increase in income and cash in the bank at 30 June 2023 of \$18,213.23.



Treasurer's Report

Expenditure

Total Expenditure for the year was **\$30,028.54**.

Equipment purchase(s) continue to be the largest expense for our club, with significant investment made during the year into our straight track timing gates. This purchase was largely offset by community grants and sponsorships and position our club for future growth and positive competition day experiences for our members.

Uniform expenses were our second largest expense for the year coming in at \$8,342.33; this expense was offset by uniform/merchandise sales of \$3,631.92.

In terms of other expense items, ground management (including line marking and turf repair), equipment storage, oval hire and IT expenses are the next largest line items incurred this year.




Statement by the Committee of Management

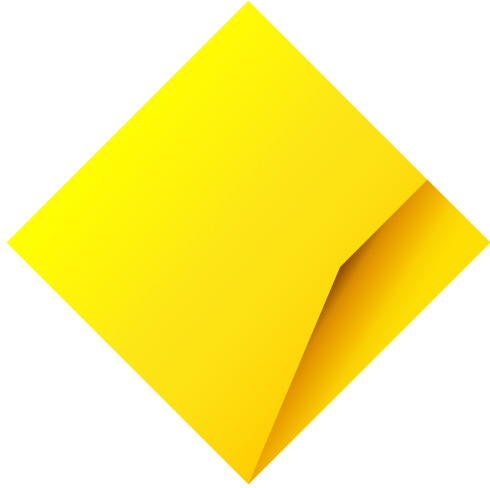
